Local Beaches

- **Atlantic City Boardwalk**—Take a left out of Campground north to the Parkway and follow the Parkway signs about 30 miles to Atlantic City.
- **Cape May**—Take a right out of Campground going south about 15 miles.
- **Ocean City Boardwalk**—Go north on Rt 9 approximately 10 miles to the fourth light. Turn right, go straight to the beach block, and turn left.
- **Wildwood Boardwalk**—Go south on Rt 9 to the first traffic light, turn left, go ½ mile to the Parkway South on ramp, follow the Parkway to Exit 4B, turn right and go straight to the beach block.

Campground Guidelines and Courtesies

Our rules are for everyone's benefit.

Please review them with your camping family and group.

VISITORS: All visitors must register and pay a fee upon arrival. Registered campers are responsible for their visitors.

VEHICLES: Two vehicles per site are permitted. Extra vehicles must be parked in a designated parking lot, and all vehicles must display a valid pass. All vehicles without a valid pass are subject to be towed at owner's expense.

SPEED LIMIT: The speed limit is 10 MPH throughout the Campground and is strictly enforced. **Please observe.** Pedestrians have the right of way.

BICYCLES: No bicycle riding after sunset or in designated areas. State law requires helmets.

PETS: All pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Your pet is your responsibility. Clean up after your pet on or off your site, and respect others by keeping your pet controlled and **quiet.** Do not leave your pet unattended. Pets are **not permitted in any building,** pool area or mini-golf course. **PETS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN ANY RENTAL UNIT OR ON ANY RENTAL SITE.**

CHILDREN: Parents are responsible for the safety and actions of their children. Children age 6 and under must be accompanied to the bathhouse, pond area and mini-golf course. **All children under age 18** must be back at their campsite by 11 PM.

TREES: No cutting, defacing or destroying of trees or foliage. Do not take any wood. Wood may be purchased in the store.

SWIMMING POOL: SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. Our pool is open daily from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend (circumstances permitting). When no pool attendant is on duty, you must be at least age 16, or under parental supervision to enter the pool area. Anyone under age 16 must always have parental supervision. **Please obey all posted rules.**

TELEPHONE MESSAGES AND MAIL. Only absolute **emergency** messages will be delivered. Please see that your family and friends understand this rule.

CHURCH SERVICES: A non-denominational service is held in our Hall April through Sept. Casual attire is fine; please join us!

NO SMOKING INSIDE ANY CAMPGROUND BUILDING, including restrooms **or any rental unit.** Please deposit cigarette butts in appropriate containers outside buildings. Please do not put on the ground or porches.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES are permitted at campsites only. **NO KEGS PERMITTED.** Disorderly conduct, loud or profane language will not be permitted.

REFUNDS: No refunds will be given due to discomforts of nature or early departure.

TRASH: Put all garbage in plastic bags and place in the Dumpster at the exit. Please help us recycle. Recycle containers are located throughout the Campground. Please do not place garbage in the recycle containers. Do not leave trash at a campsite. **FURNITURE, HAZARDOUS WASTE, APPLIANCES, GRILLS, ETC, MAY NOT BE PLACED IN THE DUMPSTERS.**

FIREWORKS AND FIREARMS are not permitted on the premises.

FIRES: All campfires must be contained in fire rings and kept small. Extinguish all fires before retiring or leaving campsite. **Do not move fire rings.**

PROPANE may be purchased in the Office.

ELECTRICITY AND WATER should be used conservatively. **No washers or dryers permitted. No clotheslines and no tarps allowed.** Car washing or trailer washing is prohibited. **We do not provide electrical adapters.**

STATE LAW: Do not drain wastewater onto a campsite. No draining of sink water onto the ground. Use the Dump Station for trailers and Porta-Potties. Seals must be used on all sewer connections. Dumping of gray and black water onto the ground is prohibited.
